

## How to use your quart bottle of $\mathcal{ERASE}$ in hotels or homes

<u>Please test this product in a standard size guestroom</u> as these instructions are specifically directed towards the application of a standard size guestroom.

NOTE: The instructions below are for a **SEVERE** smoke odor problem. Less product is needed in a room with less smoke odor.

## Initial Treatment Procedure

If a room has never been treated for smoke odor problems, this procedure *may* need to be repeated. (Once a day for three consecutive days)

- 1. Turn the fan of the AC/Heater on HIGH in the rooms to be treated, close the curtains to reveal the entire fabric surface.
- 2. Turn the sprayer nozzle to the 'mist' setting.
- 3. Spray ERASE liberally into the air return vent of your AC/Heater (4 to 5 sprays).
- 4. Liberally spray up and away from face in each room.
  - Bathroom: 3 sprays
  - Bedrooms and living areas: 10 to 15 sprays.
- 5. Spray toward the curtains, over chairs, and over the bedspreads. The *Erase* mist should also float down on the carpet. *ERASE* is alcohol based and will not harm any fabrics with the exception of silk. Always test fabric for color fastness or water markings before treatment.
- 6. After leaving the room for 15 to 30 minutes, you will smell an appreciable improvement in the odor. The light powder scent will disappear, leaving the room odor neutral.
- 7. If the room has been smoked in for a long period, the above procedure may need to be repeated to absolutely eliminate all smoke odors.

## Maintenance Treatment Procedure

After a room has been treated initially and all smoke odors are gone, Housekeeping should mist each room daily with 4 to 5 sprays. Additional treatments of the AC/Heater return should be determined by the amount of ongoing smoke odor introduced in the room.

## TAKE THE TEST!

Feel confidant when using  $\mathcal{ERASE}$  in all areas of your operation that are affected by cigarette, cigar or any smoke related odors (conference rooms, offices, lounges, bars, restaurants, ballrooms, and vehicles).

Please Note: ERASE does not require mixing or diluting, and should not be used in a fogger.
